The Vikings will return to Jersey's shores this February half term for a week of action-packed fun at the Maritime Museum.

Nicky Lucas, Jersey Heritage's Community Events Curator, said: "We haven't seen the Vikings since 2020 and we can't wait to welcome them back to our shores! They are always so much fun and families have a fantastic experience when they come to the Maritime Museum for our Viking

events. As well as lots of crafts and activities, there will be the opportunity to take part in a reenactment of the Battle of Stamford Bridge, a battle that most historians agree marked the end of the Viking era. Dressing up is optional but it does make the experience even more fun!"

Normal entry fees apply, with free entry for Jersey Heritage Members and children under six years old.
