Alex will be discussing the recent UK Court of Appeal decision which appears to challenge the commonly held view that blessing applications afford full protection to trustees from proceedings brought by third parties and beneficiaries.

Whilst the case concerned the sale of a football club's assets by a Receiver the judgment referred extensively to trust principles and in particular Public Trustee v Cooper applications in relation to trustee immunity from legal action.

Alex will be discussing the effect of this judgment on Guernsey trust proceedings.
