Powers provide the legal authority for trustees (or other fiduciaries) to dispose of or deal with property which is not their own. This talk will consider the exercise of express and implied powers in the context of trusts, in particular focussing on the perils and pitfalls for trustees to avoid when carrying out their duties. - How should powers be exercised?
- Why is any of this relevant to trustees and other fiduciaries
